After graduating from William Penn Senior High School, Ms. Foxworthy joined the U.S. Navy. She became an Ocean Systems Technical Analyst detecting enemy submarines. After completing Naval Aircrew Candidate training to become an Aircrewman, Ms. Foxworthy flew in combat missions in support of three wars. She retired from the Navy as a Chief Petty Officer in 2013. She has since earned several college degrees and reinvented herself as a motivational speaker and businesswoman. She delivered the commencement speech to the William Penn Class of 2018. Now 45, Ms. Foxworthy lives in Lusby, Md.

### WHAT DO YOU CONSIDER YOUR GREATEST ACHIEVEMENT SO FAR?

My greatest achievement is giving the Class of 2018 commencement speech. As an alumni of William Penn and a professional motivational speaker, this was the highlight of my career as well as giving back to my hometown.

### WHAT IS SOMETHING THAT PEOPLE WOULD BE SURPRISED TO LEARN ABOUT YOU?

While serving as a Naval Aircrewman in the Navy, I became the first in three different categories during my squadron tours. I have flown combat missions in three different wars. I have been to over 27 different countries. I have been to 49 out of the 50 states (North Dakota is the only state I haven't visited.)
