Health and Safety Plan Requirements

- Continue to use the same template for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Reminder: Under ESSER requirements, LEAs must still review or update their Health and Safety Plan every six months up through September 30, 2024.
- Updated plans must be posted on your website, but you do not need to submit them to PDE.

LEA Mandated and District Expectations

- Exclusion criteria for staff and students:
 - Exclude until fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication.
- If you feel sick, test with COVID symptoms. Take a Covid test at home or in a medical facility when symptomatic.
 - Please don't wait because you may spread your germs.
 - Follow CDC guidelines for quarantine.
 - Five days quarantine from the start of symptoms or positive test results, whichever comes first. Then, wear a mask for five additional days.
- Report Positive results for COVID, RSV, or Influenza to school nurse.
- LEA must report an outbreak or suspected outbreak of COVID-19, RSV, or Flu to DOH.
- Individual cases do not need to be reported to the DOH.

Facilities Cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting & ventilation

- The SDCY maintenance and custodial staff will implement proper disinfection procedures for cleaning classrooms, offices, and common areas after hours and during the school day as needed.
- The staff, faculty and administration will be provided disinfection supplies to be used in classrooms and offices during the school day.
- High traffic areas, including restrooms, handrails, and hallways, will be cleaned as needed during the course of the day.
